A two to three-page (double-spaced) personal statement indicating your intellectual goals in applying for the English Speaking Union Scholarship with a description of the specific course of study you would like to pursue through the International Summer School Programs in the United Kingdom (consult web links at [www.esuky.org](http://www.esuky.org) [Kentucky] and [www.englishspeakingunion.org](http://www.englishspeakingunion.org) [National]) and your area-specific qualifications to undertake the program of study you select. Your statement should give evidence of your writing abilities, maturity, motivation, and your adaptability to new circumstances. How do your objectives for studying abroad compare to the English Speaking Union's mission and objectives? (The ESU is committed to promoting scholarship and the advancement of knowledge through the effective use of English in an expanding global community.) How will you apply the personal experience of British culture when you return home? You will be required to write papers which will be graded by the institution you select. Your statement should reflect your ability and willingness to write such papers.
